SUMMARY OF ACTIVITIES
FOR THE PERIOD FROM AUGUST 24, 2022 TO DECEMBER 26, 2022

Government of Sindh (GoS) has established the “Sindh Flood Relief Fund” to help out the affected persons in the wake of the recent torrential rains and flash floods throughout the Province of Sindh. A Steering Committee for the Fund has been constituted to supervise and provide strategic direction for rehabilitation, short and long term welfare and financial well-being of flood affected persons. The committee is headed by Chief Secretary, Sindh with following members:

- i. Senior Member, Board of Revenue / Relief Commissioner
- ii. The Secretary Finance
- iii. Secretary Rehabilitation Department
- iv. Secretary Social Protection Department
- v. Chief Executive Officer, Sindh Rural Support Organization
- vi. Chief Executive Officer, National Rural Support Organization
- vii. Chief Executive Officer, Akhuwat

The contribution in SFRF is to be made from both public as well as private sector. Government of Sindh has contributed 2 Days and 5 Days Salary for BPS 1-16 and BPS 17-21 respectively, from salary contributions of government employees & autonomous bodies, whereas Honorable Chief Minister, Sindh / Ministers / MPAs (PPP only) / Advisors / Special Assistant to Chief Minister / Parliamentary Secretaries contributing One Month's Salary. The private donations has already contributed donations amounting to Rs. 42.347 million. These donations shows commitment from the public, to partner with Government of Sindh in the fight against flood relief activities. To ensure smooth facilitation as well as transparency for private donors, Finance Department has established a link (<https://finance.gos.pk/Covid/FloodReliefFund>) on it's website whereby public interested in donations to SFRF will be properly guided, as well as get access to complete transaction details of the SFRF.
